Second area of consideration will go to any qualified U.S. Citizen**DUTIES:** The complete Functional Statement may be reviewed in Human Resources Management Division. The following duties and responsibilities are taken from the functional statement and are considered to be a brief extract. The Chief of Imaging Service, which includes Radiology and Nuclear Medicine, provides educational, research and clinical guidance to the physician staff and is the Medical Center representative for all clinical issues pertaining to Medical Imaging. The candidate would be eligible for commensurate academic rank with the affiliated Oregon Health Science University (OHSU) Department of Diagnostic Radiology. The Portland VA Medical Center is physically connected to OHSU and the Diagnostic Imaging Services of both institutions have a close clinical, educational and academic relationship. The Medical Imaging Department delivers comprehensive inpatient and outpatient radiologic and nuclear medicine services within a tertiary care medical center environment. The Department features state of the art technology with 2 Siemens Angio Suites (1 operating room ready), 1 Philips MRI Scanner, 2 GE Helical Scanners (1 Lightspeed), 3 Acuson (2 Sequoia) Ultrasound Units, Vista Imaging Picture Archive and Communications System (PACS) with an L&H Powerscribe voice recognition transcription system. The Department performs approximately 75,000 exams annually. The Department presently consists of 9.5 radiology staff with fellowship-trained experience in body, thoracic, musculoskeletal, GI/GU, neuro, angio-interventional and nuclear medicine imaging. In addition, through a joint program with OHSU, a rotational group of 3 radiology residents, 1 angio fellow and 1 nuclear medicine fellow assist in the daily delivery of care.
